Cupcake creations include “Chocolate Elvis” (banana cake frosted with peanut-butter buttercream and a dollop of chocolate ganache) and the seductive “Forget Love, I’d Rather Fall in Chocolate” (devil’s-food cake frosted with chocolate buttercream). Rogers indulges her customers by using gourmet ingredients, such as Madagascar vanilla, Belgian chocolate, and Florida strawberries. Even brides are jumping into the game by ordering three-tiered cupcake trees instead of regular wedding cakes.
